RESIDENTIAL COMPOST BIN PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS and CUSTOMER AGREEMENT

1. Applicant must be a City of Watsonville resident or utility customer (garbage services) to qualify for a compost bin. Proof of address is required. Limit one per household.
2. Complete a 15 minute "Compost 101 Training" to learn how to compost.

5. Compost bin can be delivered or picked up after completing "step 4". Delivery will take approximately one week and pick-up is available at 320 Harvest Dr. during business hours.
6. Residents can contact or visit the Nature Center for additional assistance with their compost bin.
7. If residents no longer want to compost or use bin, they must contact Customer Service at (831) 768-3133 and the bin will be picked up at no charge. The initial \$10 fee is non-refundable. The compost bin is property of the City of Watsonville.
